A dedicated team of trained counsellors are deputed for online counselling the students. The students would be provided complete information through call, email and chat facility provided on the website. We would also conduct online webinars with prospective students and provide complete information for the programs enabling students to enroll.

The LMS system have various users like System Admin, Program Co-ordinator, Course Co-ordinator, Course Mentors, Examiners apart from Students. The process and the skills required are as follows: a. Production of E-Content / Digitization of the content in multiple formats: □ Skills necessary for conversion of base content from word file to PDF, HTML5, Scorm Files using various tools like adobe illustrator, articulate rise, storyline etc. In case of videos, skills necessary for editing the raw video, audio /video editing facilities adding multi media components using tools like aftereffect, camptasia, adobe flash etc. b. Creation of Online Course : Skills : Basic Understanding required for creating the online course in LMS system with final version of approved content at unit / chapter level within a course/subject. Invigilator receives candidate real time photograph and ID and matches with previous data set provided by the candidate during registration. After Invigilator approves a candidate his test will be activated on the desktop and candidates can start the exam. Candidate's video and active screen will be visible to invigilators. Each Physical Remote Proctor - Invigilator can monitor up to 40-50 candidates at one go. The student would need to complete the aadhar card verification process (OTP based) followed by technology based student online confirmation provided by invigilator stationed at university control centre before the assessment starts. The system would capture images of students every 2 minutes during the exam conduction and the central invigilators would be able to access their systems from the university control centre. Other security features like screen navigation, alerts and warning system are enabled during these assessments.
